



CUC Ovens Murray Newsletter

Welcome to our end of year newsletter. It has been an exciting year establishing CUC Ovens Murray in Corryong, Wangaratta and Mansfield. We were able to get all three sites operating during Semester One and have now supported 50 students across the Ovens Murray region.

CUC Ovens Murray supports **any student**, **studying any course - at any university or higher education provider**, by providing free access to a dedicated learning space (7 days/week 7ammidnight), free printing, dual screen computers and academic support. So, anybody in our region currently enrolled in a higher education course at any university or higher education provider can register, access the centre and use our services for **free**. For some of our students it is a space they can come and study without the distractions of home, for others it is for academic support, for some it's the reliable internet or the ability to print, sit an online exam or a combination of these things.
